WHY ARE THEY NEEDED?

We receive thousands of requests each year for double drawstring bags, as they're perfect for charities to fill with essentials and secure at the top. The bags are used for clothes and toys for children entering foster care, or toiletries and necessities for people in DV refuges, refugee support, or homelessness. We also use large laundry-sized ones to transport donations, and smaller versions for items like nursing pad packs. Versatile and practical, these bags are a core essential for us and many other charities.

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FABRIC CHOICES

FABRIC PRINTS

Please choose fabrics that spread kindness and comfort. We ask you to avoid prints with war, violence, alcohol, gambling or family themes so every item we make feels safe and uplifting for the people who receive them. Think fun, colourful kids prints, plain fabrics and everything inbetween.

FABRIC TYPES

Medium-weight fabrics are a great all-rounder (just check the print direction). Poplin works nicely for smaller bags, and bigger bags love the strength of soft furnishing fabrics.

PATTERN/ TUTORIAL

There are lots of great tutorials online—pick whichever one inspires you most while remembering:

- Preferred sizes Laundry / A3/ A4/ A5
- Finish the seams
- Double drawstring casing

Note: We can string them at HQ if needed, just pop a note in your parcel
