MARBLE MAZE

WHY ARE THEY NEEDED?

Sensory items are helpful for all ages, especially children, people with disabilities, and the elderly. Marble mazes are a popular choice—calming, versatile, and great for fine motor, hand, and visual skills.

WHAT FABRIC DO I USE TO MAKE THEM?

- · A great project to use up scrap fabrics
- Bright fabrics, cotton, fleece, flannel, jersey, or a cotton-polyester blend
- Consider colours and suitable patterns for men, women, children, neutrals
- A solid colour on one side of the maze can be helpful visually, but not absolutely necessary.
- You will also need a marble

PATTERN/TUTORIAL

It can be any shape or size, the smaller ones are good for young children, the larger ones are good for all other ages. Please make sure the marble can travel through all areas of the maze,





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CAN I MAKE THESE ON AN EMBROIDERY MACHINE?
