They're comforting for people undergoing cancer treatment, cheerful in kids' fabrics for children in foster care or school bags, and for adults or seniors they brighten a toiletries bag, handbag, or make a thoughtful little gift. They are also a great scrap buster!

Please choose fabrics that spread kindness and comfort. We ask you to avoid prints with war, violence, alcohol, gambling or family themes so every item we make feels safe and uplifting for the people who receive them. Think fun, colourful kids prints, plain fabrics and everything inbetween.

FABRIC TYPES

Medium-weight fabrics are a great all-rounder (just check the print direction). Poplin works nicely for smaller bags, and bigger bags love the strength of soft furnishing fabrics.

There are lots of great tutorials online—pick whichever one inspires you most!
