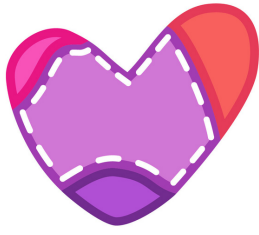

This is a great scrap buster!

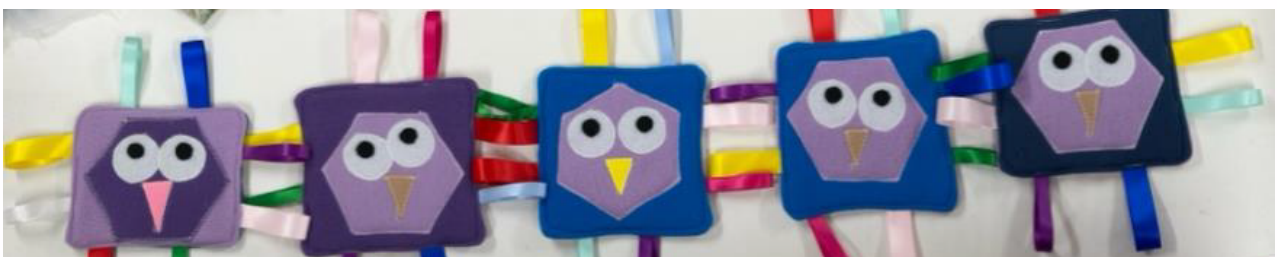
Fabrics: cotton, flannel, fleece, or minky (or similar)
