WHY ARE THEY NEEDED?



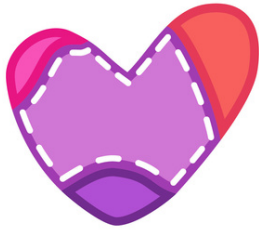

WHAT DO I USE TO MAKE THEM?

Fabric & yarn choices will depend on your project

- Boys and men are often forgotten, please consider doing some neutral or inclusive fabric colours.
- Also consider making juggling balls, bears, cute monsters, dinosaurs, figures from popular culture – even fruit and worms get a giggle!

- All eyes and facial features must be sewn on. No safety eyes, stick on eyes, loose ribbons etc
