BABY WRAPS

WHY ARE THEY NEEDED?

A baby wrap (sometimes called a swaddle or receiving blanket) is a soft, lightweight blanket used to wrap and comfort newborn babies. They help keep little ones warm, settled and secure.

Baby wraps are one of our most requested handmade items. They are gifted to families in need, maternity wards, crisis services and community organisations supporting vulnerable parents and newborns.

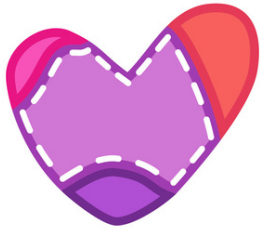
WHAT FABRIC DO I USE TO MAKE THEM?

- Flannelette
- Cotton muslin
- Soft cotton jersey
- Soft poly cotton knits

Fabrics should be new or near-new, pre-washed and free from stains, odours or damage

WHAT SIZE DO I MAKE THEM?

Finished sizes approximately 100cm x 120cm, up to 120cm x 150cm at most

FINISHING GUIDELINES

- Neatly hem all four sides or use a rolled hem
- No raw edges
- Secure stitching with no loose threads
- No embellishments, buttons or trims that could pose a safety risk
